Course content

At Wetherby High School students currently in Year 11 will undertake a personalised 1-year curriculum to finish preparations for their GCSE examinations. Every lesson in Year 11 will be used to consolidate and extend existing knowledge, whilst also developing well rounded, GCSE ready mathematicians. Students will learn different topics throughout the year, however, lessons will have a common theme; high challenge, high pace, high expectations. Through the various topics we aim to develop students who can problem solve and reason mathematically.

Topics Covered

In contrast to Year 7,8,9 & 10, the topics which students study in Y11 will be specifically selected by their class teacher. These topics will be chosen from Question Level Analysis which is conducted after mock examinations. Members of staff will select topics, from the assessment, which students are weak at in order to close gaps and enable our students to make progress.
