- Complete the DIRT work in your book – this will help you reach your target
- Check the spelling of keywords in your work
- Ask questions if you are struggling with a topic – remember 3B4me!
- Try and engage with the different topics - you could spend time teaching a friend who is struggling or making a quiz for the class!
- Remain motivated and focussed in lessons - this will help you develop your Geography skills!

Challenge Beyond the Classroom

- Have regular spelling tests about keywords
- Watch movie/film clips which relate to the topic you are studying
- Access the Home Learning provided each half term. These will help develop what you are learning about in the lessons.
- Whenever you visit or hear about a new place, locate it on a map. This will really help you build a sense of where places are in relation to each other.
