

**Making progress:**

- Check your spelling, punctuation and grammar. Remember capital letters for names or people and places!
- Respond to feedback in your green pen when work has been DIRT/STAR marked. Then use this to improve your next piece of work and demonstrate progress.
- Aim higher: Challenge yourself by choosing a task you might find difficult, don't always opt for the easy option as you will learn faster this way!
- Stuck menu: before you ask your teacher consider the following options: Brain; can I answer this myself? Buddy; does the person sitting next to or around me know? Book; is there a book that I could use in the classroom to help me answer this question? Lastly I'm totally stuck, I'll ask the BOSS (teacher!)

Challenge beyond the classroom

- Research: If you have found a topic that interests you and you would like to learn more about it, then research this in your own time and impress your teacher by presenting them with a cool fact you have learnt at the start of the next lesson.
- Home Learning: Choose tasks which support/ challenge your learning in lessons. Hand these into your teacher for marking.
