

Top Tips for Making Progress in MFL

- Learn vocabulary regularly – little and often is beneficial
- Test yourself on the vocabulary regularly
- Practise the four skills of listening, reading, speaking and writing outside of lessons.
This could be through: Online language learning websites
- Vocabulary games
- Listening to music/watching a film/video clips in the language
- Reading a story/poem/news article
- Online exercises for speaking/writing
- Grammar exercises
- Use a dictionary – this can include an online dictionary (online translators should not be used)
- Take part in language competitions

Challenge Beyond the Classroom

- Research the culture of the countries where the language is spoken
- Extend vocab around the topic from what is taught in class
- Learn a new language
