

Making progress:

- Learn vocabulary regularly – little and often is beneficial
- Test yourself on the vocabulary regularly
- Practise the four skills of listening, reading, speaking and writing outside of lessons. This could be through:
 - * Online language learning websites
 - * Vocabulary games
 - * Listening to music/watching a film/video clips in the language
 - * Reading a story/poem/news article
 - * Online exercises for speaking/writing
 - * Grammar exercises
 - * Use a dictionary – this can include an online dictionary (online translators should not be used)
 - * Participating in language competitions

Challenge outside the classroom:

- Research the culture of the countries where the language is spoken
- Extend vocab around the topic taught in class
- Learn a new language
