	Acceptable	Not Acceptable
Trousers	Plain dark trousers suit/ tailored.	No leggings, jeans, denim, tracksuit bottoms, or shorts
Shirt	Collar and tie (boys) Tailored, with a collar for girls / blouse with appropriate neck line	No sleeveless, or see through shirts/ blouses to be worn. No crop tops No T shirts No inappropriate slogans
Skirts	Tailored - appropriate length – mid thigh is the shortest	No “body con” tight fitting skirts.
Dresses	Tailored – appropriate length – mid thigh is the shortest and appropriate neck line	No “body con” dresses No play suits
Jumpers / cardigans	Plain, v or round neck with shirt/ blouse underneath	No large logos No sweatshirts or hoodies
Jackets	Suit and business style jackets	Outdoor clothing to be removed in school – no denim jackets or baseball caps
Shoes	Smart shoes/ boots	No trainers, UGG style boots, pumps, excessively high heels
Piercings and tattoos	Discreet earrings only	No facial piercings and tattoos should be covered.
Hair	To be acceptable for an office environment
