### **Year 8 Trip - The Yorkshire Sculpture Park – 27th September 2018**

The Art department at Wetherby High School are pleased to be organising a trip to The Yorkshire Sculpture Park (near Wakefield), for all Year 8 students as part of their extended enrichment. The trip will give the students the opportunity to see various traditional and contemporary sculptural works throughout the galleries and grounds; invaluable to their progression in school coursework and themselves as young artists. We fully intend all Year 8 students to join us on this trip. We will leave school at 9am and return for 3pm.

Your son or daughter will be required to bring a packed lunch/drink for the trip. Students in receipt of free school meals will be provided with a lunch.

Entrance to the park is free but there is a minimal cost of £5.50 to pay for transport to and from the park, this can be paid via parent pay.

Students whose parents are in receipt of the following support payments may be entitled to the remission of charges for this trip.

- Universal Credit in prescribed circumstances
- Income Support
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is NOT entitled to Working Tax Credit and whose annual income (as assessed by HMRC) does not exceed £16,190
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- An income related employment and support allowance
