Course Content

Students in Year 11 prepare to sit their exams in Language and Literature. They will sit the AQA syllabus in both courses. Students will be expanding, re-viewing and revising their knowledge and understanding of ‘Macbeth’, ‘Jekyll and Hyde’ and ‘An Inspector Calls’. They will also study the links between poems from the AQA Power and Conflict anthology. Students will be guided through the Language exam papers as well as sitting two sets of mock exams.

Skills developed

- Knowledge and understanding of context and how contextual information shapes our reading of a text.
- GCSE Language Paper exam skills: identifying the effect of language, identifying and explaining language techniques, identifying and explaining structural techniques.
- Essay writing skills.
- Revision skills.
