The year 9 course provides students with a firm foundation upon which to study the language at GCSE. All skill areas are developed through topic work and a range of different activities and media are used. In the Spring term the film ‘Au Revoir les Enfants’ by Louis Malle is studied followed by the topic of jobs and future careers. In the summer term students learn to talk about a past holiday ending with a mini project on the World Cup.
