### Year: 11

#### **OVERVIEW**

Next half-term you will be preparing for the actual speaking exam as well as continuing to practise reading, writing and listening skills in all topic areas.

#### **Task 1 - Vocabulary:**

- Make a spider diagram with key vocabulary on it for each sub-topic within the three themes. This should summarise the topic area. Ensure you use either Higher or foundation vocabulary.
- Make a list of 'golden' vocabulary that you will use in your general conversation answers. Ensure you use vocabulary appropriate for your tier or entry at foundation or higher

#### **Task 2 – Speaking:**

- Choose two photographs – make a recording describing each of them. Use a range of tenses and ask a question
- Practise speaking about each of the different topic areas and make a recording of them
- Make a recording of you asking questions on each topic area for your German partner to answer

#### **Task 3 – Reading:**

- Complete a practise reading paper

#### **Task 4 – Listening:**

#### **Task 5 – Writing:**

- Choose 4 topic areas from the sub-themes. Write an email on each one to your German partner using eTwinning.
