Course content

Year 11 History sees students complete their GCSE content focusing on Paper 1 and 2 of the GCSE. Students master their GCSE skills of Source Analysis and Explanation by focusing on the development of Public Health in Britain from 1250-present. Students then study Anglo-Saxon England and the impact of the Norman Invasion in 1066. Finally, students will complete their Paper 2 History Around Us content looking at several key themes associated with monastic Britain and the history of Fountains Abbey, the largest Cistercian monastery in Britain.
