

# User Guide for the pupil platform at Wetherby

## What is the Pupil Platform?

The pupil platform (aka Moodle) is a website that connects you to your school. Teachers can place important resources on it that you can see from a tablet, phone or computer.

You can also hand in work, get feedback from your teachers and message teachers directly about your work.

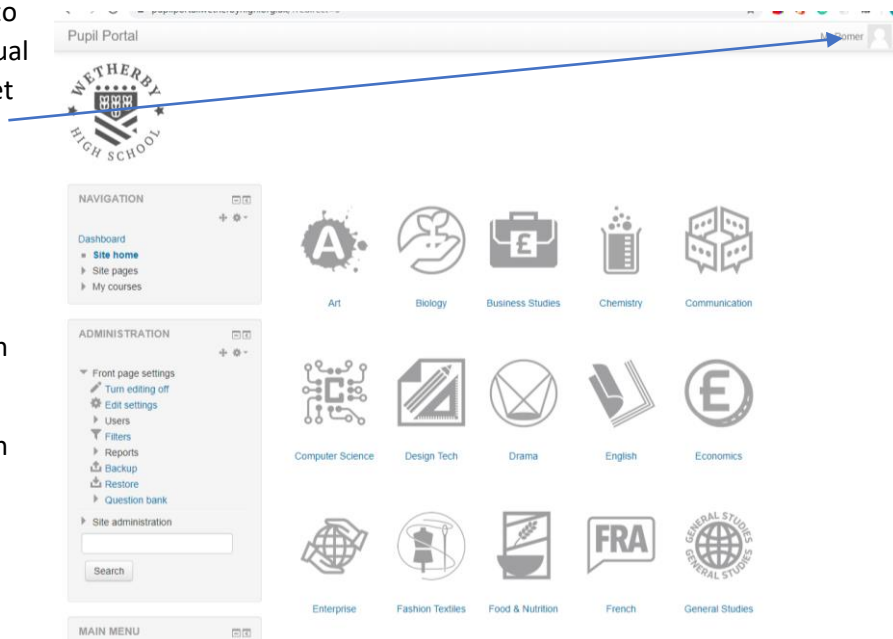
## How do I get to it?

The easiest way to get to it is through the Wetherby High School website ([www.wetherbyhigh.org.uk](http://www.wetherbyhigh.org.uk)).

Click the Students link at the top of the page to get to the home page, below.



The first thing you then need to do is to log into the site. Do this using your usual username and password you use to get onto the computers at school.



All courses begin with the year you started high school.

Year 11 will look for courses that begin with “2015 Entry”.

Year 10 will look for courses that begin with “2016 Entry”.

Year 9 will look for courses that begin with “2017 Entry”.

Year 8 will look for courses that begin with “2018 Entry”.

Year 7 will look for courses that begin with “2019 Entry”.

For each subject that you do, you will need to find your course and select “Enrol Me”. You only need to do this once. You are now in the class and can see your tasks and hand in work.
