
Well done to the endeavour running group who have been out of school, running along the Harland way, in some very cold weather!

Well done to all involved.








Students studying drama in Year 9 have been working on a unit called Mask Theatre.



All the Senior Citizens were appreciative of the hard work and talent of the students performing and thoroughly enjoyed their time with us.




It was a pleasure to see our Class of 2024 return to school on the evening of Tuesday 3rd December.


