
HALF-TERM 1 REVIEW

- A calculator. Using calculators fluently is a key part of being a good mathematician. They will be used in most lessons and are allowed in 2 out of 3 of their GCSE Maths exams at the end of Year 11. Casio scientific calculators are recommended by the maths team.

YEAR 10 MOCK EXAMS

25TH - 29TH NOVEMBER

Students in Year 10 will be sitting their first set of mock exams in November. The purpose of these mock exams is for:



- Students to experience what exams feel like by sitting them in the theatre and following exam regulations. This supports them to become comfortable with the process of sitting exams ahead of Year 11 and the real GCSEs in the summer of 2026!
- A chance for students to demonstrate their knowledge of their subjects so that teachers can identify gaps and misconceptions to allow students to make progress.

Students will receive a personalised timetable that will detail which exams they have, and where they will sit.
