Right now, teenagers across the UK are

facing a perfect storm: a mental health crisis, rising school absence rates, and a world increasingly lived through screens. The long summer holidays can also intensify a sense of isolation for our teenagers, not least because of a lack of age-appropriate alternative

Nail it and Thrive is a creative new initiative based in Leeds that tackles these issues head-on. The innovative nail art course, which will run over the summer, is designed to give teenagers a fun, accessible way to connect with others, express themselves, and gain a recognised Silver Arts Award qualification - without any exams.



This isn't just about having the best nails for summer. It's about helping teens combine the joy of creative learning with face-to-face, hands-on connection. The course offers flexible learning options, including the option of (i) a mix of live online and pre-recorded sessions or (ii) entirely pre-recorded sessions – ideal for individuals or friends to follow and practice together over the summer. Participants join a private online community to connect, share ideas, and are encouraged to complete activities together, including those involving the wider

The course is currently discounted to £355.50 (10% off). This can be paid in full or in instalments over 3 or 12 months. This price includes the course, portfolio marking and feedback, and submission to Trinity College London for the award - offering excellent value.
