YEAR 11 POST 16 OPTIONS


Year 11s have been attending Post 16 talks during PSHCE to gain a better understanding on what courses they would like to choose for their future after Wetherby High School.


























Wow, what a game! The Year 8 boys reacted really well to going a goal down early on in the match to lead 2-1,
